

HELPFUL HINTS FROM THOSE IN THE KNOW

	CHECK
<p>PARKING AND ACCESS Please ensure approx. 50' is reserved for the removal van on the day of your removal.</p>	
<p>INSURANCE Your own insurance may be sufficient cover for your particular requirements. If in doubt, please discuss with your removal representative.</p>	
<p>PACKING If you can afford to do so, leave the packing to your trained and experienced BAR team. However, if you are set on packing yourselves ask Kings to supply you with the correct and recommend packing materials. Start your packing early. We also feel that involving all the family in the packing process can help, particularly Children, adjust to the move – allowing them to feel in control.</p>	
<p>APPLIANCES Gas stoves, washing machines etc. will or may require the attention of a specialist for disconnection and installation. It is a good idea to plan this in advance.</p>	
<p>FRIDGES AND FREEZERS These appliances are not designed to be moved when frozen. Therefore we recommend helping avoid any damage you defrost and empty 24 hours in advance, and when in final position, we recommend for your appliances remain off for a further 12 hours.</p>	
<p>SELF ASSEMBLY FURNITURE The taking apart and reassembling the furniture is not part of the standard contract of removals.</p>	
<p>METRES AND TELEPHONES Arrange to have Metres read at the last available date, and arrange for the telephone bill to coincide with the removal date.</p>	
<p>LAUNDRY Make sure that the last wash was completed in plenty of time so that clothes can be washed and dried prior to your washing machine being disconnected and your last boxes packed.</p>	
<p>'DO NOT REMOVE' Anything which is not going with Kings, clearly label 'DO NOT REMOVE'. It is good practice to also advise the removal supervisor</p>	
<p>KEYS Make sure your solicitor has transferred the money for your new home so that you are in possession of the keys to your new home by the moving day.</p>	
<p>DON'T FORGET Emptying of attic is to be carried out by the customer. When leaving the old property it is the responsibility of the owner to make sure it is empty.</p>	

MOVING DAY KIT

We suggest you keep the following with you on your moving day:

- Valuables
- Important documents
- Telephone numbers for plumber, electrician etc.
- Toilet rolls
- Light bulbs
- Torch
- First aid kit
- Cash
- And importantly, a basic catering kit: Kettle, cups, tea and milk
